NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL...

Teachers attended a staff development day on Monday where we learned additional information about the iReady program. The first step in the program is a diagnostic assessment that results in specific skills and concepts identified for each student when working in the program. As students complete the diagnostic for reading and math at school they are able to access the online intervention at school and home. Students can receive remedial instruction to address skill gaps, or they may work on more challenging assignments depending on the diagnostic results. Students will work in the program at school, but they may also work at home once the diagnostic is completed. Most students know their log on and password information. If you need it, please contact your child's teacher.

Students and staff are excited about the start of our Starstruck program next week. It is a six week program designed to teach simple dance routines to classes as a part of their PE time. The Starstruck program culminates with evening performances the week after Thanksgiving break. More information will be forthcoming in the next couple of weeks.

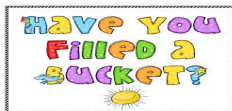
